



# STUDENT MISCONDUCTS IN EXAMINATION

## Rule 8, University of Malaya (Student Discipline) 1999

No student shall :

- Take out from or take into the examination hall any unauthorized book/ paper/ document/ graphic/ any other things.
- Receive book/paper/document/graphic/any other thing from unauthorized persons in the examination hall
- Write or have it written by other person any information/diagramme(s) on any parts of the body or clothes
- Communicate with any other student during examinations by any means
- Cheat or attempt to cheat in examinations

## University of Malaya Rules and Regulations 2019

**Master and Doctoral Degree: Regulations 44**

**Bachelor Degree: Regulations 34 (Academic Dishonesty)**

**Master and Doctoral Degree: Regulations 46 (Academic Dishonesty)**

1. Academic dishonesty may occur in various forms including but not limited to:
  - (a) plagiarism
  - (b) fabricating information
  - (c) falsifying information
  - (d) conspiring or abetting
  - (e) cheating in exams
  - (f) contract cheating and disguising
2. Any student who is found committing an act which amounts to academic dishonesty can be subject to disciplinary action by the University.
