ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR SEMESTER 1, 2020/2021 NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE)

Congratulations for being accepted into our university and our community of excellence. As a new student, below are a few important information that need your utmost attention.

1. STATUS OF ENTRY OF NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Given the current health situation, the government authority has recently announced that new international students **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED** to physically enter Malaysia to start their study program at higher education institutions.

2. ONLINE REGISTRATION

Pursuant to this, UM will be conducting online registration for the Semester I, 2020/2021 academic session to the affected new students. Thus, all new students need to activate their status at **MAYA**¹ **portal** at <u>https://maya.um.edu.my</u> and will be registered once payment of admission fee is made. Students are required to **upload** important documents during the online registration. The list of the documents can be obtained at **MAYA** portal.

Students need to pay attention to all important dates pertaining to admission fee payments at **MAYA** portal. Failure to adhere to the dates will affect the registration process. The guidelines on how to activate registration will be made available at **MAYA portal** from 1st **October 2020.**

3. TEACHING AND LEARNING MODE

Given the current health situation, the teaching and learning activities will be conducted online and the *e*-Learning mode will be in operation until **31 December 2020** (please go to <u>https://umacademic.um.edu.my/news/reminder-elearning</u> for latest information on e-Learning).

5. VISA APPLICATION

Since new international students are not allowed to physically enter the country, no Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) will be issued by the Malaysian Immigration Department from now until further notice. However, new students are required to submit application for eVAL and this can be done at the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) website at https://educationmalaysia.gov.my after receiving the offer letter from UM (a processing fee will be charged upon submission of the eVAL). guideline and updates the eVAL application available Latest on is at https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/visa-new-application/.

Students are advised to monitor the progress of eVAL application. Once it reaches **32%** (IM14U – Document ready for submission to Immigration), EMGS will issue an **Approval Letter** and students need to upload the letter to **MAYA** portal before starting online registration on 5th October 2020.

Students will not be allowed to register at **MAYA** portal until the **EMGS Approval Letter** is uploaded. Please note that **NO PHYSICAL ENTRY** to Malaysia is allowed at this point in time. This means students are **to remain in their country of origin** until further notice and register from home country.
